Membership:

Chapter Finances

Previous years we used some funds to support the work of the executive in relation to a national CCPA / ACCP function and for some members bursaries. This year due to Covid-19 and cancellations we will defer the usage until 2021.

Focus on Professional Development PD opportunities

We are still considering PD opportunities, possibly for Fall 2020 or more possibly Spring 2021. Feedback from members after a previous PD event indicated interest in best practices in couples' therapy, assessment tools, suicide assessment, counseling at end of life, poverty and mental health, culturally sensitive counselling practices for indigenous peoples, best practices for making referrals for clients, impact of stress and anxiety. Members expressed interest in topics considered to be at intermediate or advanced levels. So, we will seek a facilitator who can address one or some of these considerations. We will also likely advance education re: new CCPA Ethics standards.
