



## Dr. R. Vance Peavy Travel Bursary Career Counsellors Chapter

The Career Counsellors Chapter offers a bursary of \$300 toward attending the following national conferences:

- The Annual Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association (CCPA) conference
- The CCPA Research Conference (in years in which it is held)
- CANNEXUS

Applicants must be full-time students in graduate or other post-secondary programs in counselling, career counselling, or career development, and have research interests in career development.

Preference will be given to students who have submitted a proposal to present at one of the above conferences. Preference will also be given to CCPA members.

Please submit your application electronically to the CCPA head office and include the following in your application:

- Proof of full-time status (if you are not already a registered Student Member of the CCPA)
- A completed copy of the CCPA Award Nomination Form (you do not need a nominating signature)
- A current CV
- A one page covering letter addressing the following points:
  - Program or degree description
  - Year of studies
  - Current research/practice interests
  - Title, date, and description of conference presentation (if applicable, or a statement of what you hope to gain by attending conference if not presenting)

The **deadline for submissions** is the 15<sup>th</sup> of November.

Applications will be ranked according to the above criteria, and a decision will be made by the Chapter Executive by the second Friday in January. All applicants will be informed of the decision.

The winner will be expected to provide a summary of their presentation for inclusion in the Chapter blog, and/or to present their paper at the annual Career Counsellors Chapter meeting, typically held during the CCPA Annual Conference.
