### Activities

The Chapter continued to focus on promoting social justice awareness and action among chapter members and the CCPA membership in general.

The CSJ executive continues to hold regular teleconference meetings for strategic planning and to move forward the initiatives on which we have been working.

**Student travel award.** We voted to increase this award to \$350 from \$250. The recipient for the 2013 award was Heidi Mitton.

**Social justice event.** We remain committed to organizing a social justice event at each annual conference with a view to encouraging conference participants to get active in terms of social justice and to ensuring that CSJ leave something behind to benefit the communities where the conference is held. Proceeds from our annual silent auction at the 2013 conference raised \$1450 for Halifax's Phoenix House, a facility to help youth.

The recipient chosen by poll for the 2014 conference in Victoria is the Men's Trauma Centre.
