Workshop will be open to Indigenous and non-Indigenous healers and helpers identifying with the goals of decolonization as a means to healing and wellness. Participation is limited therefore we request that participants demonstrate an interest in and capacity to utilize the learning and techniques in their current community and work settings for the purpose of shedding light on the impact of colonizing forces, as well as developing creative antidotes and interventions to foster healing the wounds of history.

The Workshop

- Through creative arts explore the ways we heal from the traumas of colonization.
- In solidarity as peoples, explore best clinical and community practices in therapeutic arts to address the soul wounds of inter-generational trauma and heal traumatic histories of victimization and perpetration.
- Foster the development of fresh understanding and narratives to guide us into the future with accountability, repair, justice, creativity and hope.

Theatre, the expressive arts and other action methods provide a bridge between personal and collective experience and help people master complex feelings, heal deep wounds, put ghosts of history to rest and allow new narratives to emerge. Let us work together to create new possibilities for healing.
