

### Description:

This one-day introductory workshop is designed to offer a framework for best-practice clinical supervision to those who might wish to contribute in a supervisory capacity to the professional development of pre-service and in-service colleagues. Via a combination of presentation and interactive components, the workshop will provide an overview of supervision considerations such as: rationale and purpose; roles, requirements, and responsibilities; modes; theoretical models; strategies and techniques; documentation and record-keeping; assessment, evaluation, and feedback; supervision phenomena; legal and ethical issues; risk management; cultural and diversity issues; challenges and rewards; and trends and directions. It is hoped that the workshop will pique participant interest in further pursuing training in clinical supervision as an emerging and valuable specialty area of practice.
