Utilizing the spirit and intentionality of the “[Two-Eyed Seeing](#)” approach, the Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association (CCPA) embarked on a learning journey which led to the development of the new Indigenous Continuing Education Credits (CEC) Initiative – officially launched in fall 2018.

Bill Thomas (2014-2018 CCPA National Indigenous Director) originally brought the concept of Indigenous pathways for Continuing Education to the CCPA Board of Directors for review and consideration.

The Indigenous CEC Initiative recognizes and includes Indigenous pathways for CECs. Furthermore, the Indigenous CEC Initiative is intended to develop an Indigenous-informed continuing education evaluation process for CCPA members.

Four highly skilled CCPA members will be serving on the inaugural Indigenous CEC Review Panel – Danielle Lambrecht (Chair), Pamela Ana, Bill Thomas, and Jamie Warren (CCPA National Indigenous Director).
