Committee Activities

1. Student Bursary: In 2014, the CCPA Spirituality in Counselling Chapter had received approval from CCPA to create a \$500 bursary to recognize the work of students in Pastoral or Spiritual Care in Counselling and acknowledge their personal and professional commitment to the profession. This award was advertised on the CCPA and Chapter website until the deadline to February 15th, 2019.

There was 1 submission of application received for this year's award from Ms. Elizabeth Stolte studying at St. Stephen's College in Edmonton, Alberta. Upon review of the application as a chapter, it was unanimously agreed that Ms. Stolte should be granted the award. Ms. Stolte was notified of the decision, and there will be an Award Presentation in the 2019 CCPA National Conference.
