

Social Skill Program Using LEGO[®]

The LEGO[®] -Based Social Skills program has been proven to be an effective way for children ages 7 to 11 with social difficulties associated with Autism (severity level 1) and ADHD, to improve their social interactions and communications skills in a natural setting.

The program uses LEGO[®] blocks as a teaching tool to promote social skills for children with challenges in the areas of language, turn-taking, perspective-taking and self-regulation.

This program challenges them to master the skills of teamwork by exposing them and teaching them the necessary social skills to work successfully as a team and experience the benefits of teamwork.

LEGO[®] capitalizes on the fact that it is inherently rewarding and, offered in the right environment, naturally motivates aspects of constructive play.

There is a screening process to help identify the best group dynamics. The screening process is free and takes place in your home or in my office.
