



Purple Stream: Certificate in Therapeutic Play Skills

The Purple Stream: *Certificate in Therapeutic Play Skills* is 42 hours and offers specialized training in therapeutic play for those working with children and/or families. The program focuses on play-based strategies and techniques and introduces participants to a variety of play modalities and theories of play interventions based on principles of child development. This course is suited to those who would like to earn the designation of *Therapeutic Play Practitioner™* awarded by RMPTI™. It is a designated study of children, play, and development and is a good alternative for those who do not intend on becoming a registered or certified play therapist but would like to add to their current designation(s). This program is ideal for Teachers, Early Childhood Educations, School Counsellors and more!

Program Goals

The primary goals of this program are to introduce play-based and expressive activities as a way to work with children in a variety of educational and counselling settings including schools and outreach/community settings, and to enhance awareness of clinical judgment in selecting, tailoring and implementing play-based activities. Case vignettes focus on common referral issues in school and community-based settings and are related to working with minor to moderate adjustment issues. During the program two theories of play therapy practice will be reviewed: Child-Centred Play Therapy and Adlerian Play Therapy.

Entrance Requirements

- Completion of course work at College-level (minimum)
- Academic background is focused in the areas of Humanities, Health, Social Science, Education or Mental Health
 - i.e. OT, PT, Psychologist, Social Worker, Early Childhood Educator
- Relevant work experience with children and/or families
